No need to worry about videographers interrupting your ceremony by moving their equipment around. Ron's three discreetly placed "invisible" cameras are rarely noticed by guests and welcomed by clergy at some of the most exclusive wedding venues.

HeavenlyCam can get angles from up high even if your church doesn't have a balcony. With Ron's exclusive live-switching technology, your day is recorded and edited on-site in real time, thus keeping your cost down and delivering your DVD more quickly.

HeavenlyCam is like Ron's own portable balcony. His tiny, remote-controlled camera is mounted atop a flagpole that can be extended up to twenty feet in the air for soaring panoramic views.

HeavenlyCam works great at receptions, where there are usually no high balconies from which to shoot. He has used it to capture views of traditional Jewish dances in synagogues that rarely have high ceilings.

Although tall, HeavenlyCam operates noiselessly and needs no lights, in keeping with Ron's goal of being as "invisible" to guests as possible.
